CHAGAS Disease Educational Series

Chagas disease, caused by protozoan parasite Trypanosoma cruzi, affects ~8 million people in Mexico, Central & South America, and ~240,000-350,000 people in the USA. The main route of infection is through insect vectors, most frequently triatomine bugs. Chronic

phase is usually *lifelong and asymptomatic, but in 20-30% of patients* can cause severe cardiac or gastrointestinal complications. Pilot Project Aim: To conduct bi-directional workforce training and

development activities that bring together clinicians and investigators to build a learning community that will learn from each other as part of hybrid onsite/online CME-accredited trainings.

Cover Healthcare Workers (HCWs)

The goal of the proposed project is to support the mental and physical well-being of U.S. healthcare workers (HCWs) to ensure high-quality patient-centered care. Frontline HCWs are facing unprecedented stressors and are at risk of psychological distress and mental health disorders during COVID-19. Research from past infectious outbreaks suggests that the effects of COVID-19 on HCWs will be profound and long-lasting. Protecting HCWs' mental and physical well-being is critical not just in terms of the direct effects, but because patients will benefit from receiving higher quality, more efficient, and patient-centered care.
